The visits continue to go well. It was so nice for our Elders to get outdoors. I would like to take this time to remind you that while outdoors your mask is to remain on. Your loved one should wear a mask also but we understand this is not always possible. Therefore, it is most important that you keep yours on. Please ensure you hand sanitize before you leave and on your return.

For those who wish to sit outside for a length of time and visit, please bring a lawn chair. The chairs at the front of the building must not be used.

Please note that for those visiting in the suites- When you are leaving, say your goodbyes at the suite. We ask that you and your loved one not come to the main entry to do this. The entry is not to be congested with people as physical distancing becomes difficult. Thank you for your consideration.

Indoor visits

We have had a number of requests to change or swap out the essential visitors that have been designated. We will not be able to accommodate this request except in extreme circumstances.

The two designated visitors are only to be those close family and/or friends who have a clearly established pattern of involvement in providing active care and support to the resident's emotional wellbeing, health and quality of life. These family caregivers participate regularly in the care of the resident. All other visitors must utilize the outdoor visits. If coming from out of province we will make every attempt to book longer outdoor visits for you during your stay in Winnipeg.

For your information, the U of M Faculty of Dentistry that usually provides dental services in our Home has suspended services until further notice. Leaving the Home for dental services should be reserved for emergency services only. This goes for all non-urgent services you may wish to take your loved one to.
