CHRISTMAS DECORATIONS

Please ensure that any items that are plugged in such as small Christmas trees MUST be approved by Maintenance prior to use. When decorating in your loved one's suite or door, fire regulations must be adhered to. Wreaths on doors is not permitted as this is a fire code violation in this type fliving environment.

If unsure if a decoration is safe to hang in a specific location, please see Maintenance and/or a member of the Leadership Team.

Some Do's and Don'ts:

- Window cling decorations are a great option.
- Do not hang items on Elder doors.
- Be aware of electrical cords- tripping hazard.
- Items that require fire/flame are prohibited. Battery operated candles and other light displays only.
- Purchase timers for lights to make daily enjoyment easy.
- Only string battery operated lights can be used in elders' windows and rooms.
- No hanging items on or near sprinkler heads.

Additionally, as the weather becomes cooler many Elders use a space heater to provide additional warmth in their suite. All heaters **MUST** meet safety standards with an automatic turn off **AND** be pre-inspected by Maintenance before use.
